Deacon Patrick Graybill's Bio: Deacon Patrick is an accomplished Deaf actor and poet. He was born in Kansas just before World War II began. He is one of seven children, five of whom were born deaf and he has a hearing sister, who was a certified sign language interpreter. He graduated from the Kansas School for the Deaf, where an eloquent Deaf teacher whose storytelling ability inspired him to become a storyteller. He also saw his older sister in a school production of Tom Sawyer, which planted the idea of acting in his head. He graduated from Gallaudet College with a bachelor's degree in English in 1963 and a master's degree in education in 1964. He was a member of the National Theatre of the Deaf from 1969 to 1979. He retired in 2004 as a performing arts and literature professor for twenty-three years at the National Technical Institute for the Deaf and currently serves as a permanent deacon for the Diocese of Rochester, New York. For more than 35 years, he serves as deacon for the Diocese of Rochester, NY. He is skilled in translating text from English to ASL.

Sue Gudenkauf's Bio: Sue is a long time freelance interpreter. Sue was born and raised in Iowa. Sue received her B.S. in Child and Family Studies at Northern Illinois University and obtained her MA in Theology at Augustine Institute in 2013. Sue is currently the Coordinator of Deaf Ministry for the Archdiocese of Baltimore. She works with local parishes to ensure Deaf Catholics have access to the Sacraments, growing in their faith and full participation in the Life of the Catholic Church.
